## **Side Tilt Carriage**

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity. Hook type tine carriages have been uniform.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades could vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
